Assignment of Functions (Minister of Information Communication
Technology, Postal and Courier Services) Notice, 2015

IT is hereby notified that His Excellency the President, in terms of section 104(1) of the Constitution, as read with section 37(2) of the Interpretation Act [*Chapter 1:01*], has assigned to the Minister of Information Communication Technology, Postal and Courier Services:—

- (a) the administration of the Act set out in the Schedule; and
- (b) the functions conferred or imposed on the Minister of Information Communication Technology, Postal and Courier Services, save to the extent that those functions have not been assigned to some other Minister.

The Assignment of Functions (Minister of Information Communication Technology, Postal and Courier Services) Notice, 2014, published in Statutory Instrument 25 of 2014, is hereby repealed.

The Assignment of Functions (Office of the President and Cabinet) Notice, 2014, published in Statutory Instrument 19 of 2014, is amended in the Schedule by the deletion of “Postal and Telecommunications Act [*Chapter 12:05*]”.
