

Legal Practitioners (Designated Legal Qualifications)  
(Amendment) Notice, 2023 (No. 3)

IT is hereby notified that the Council for Legal Education has, in terms of section 6(1) of the Legal Practitioners (Council for Legal Education) Rules, 1992, made the following notice:—

1. This notice may be cited as the Legal Practitioners (Designated Legal Qualifications) (Amendment) Notice, 2023 (No. 3).

2. The Schedule to the Legal Practitioners (Designated Legal Qualifications) (Amendment) Notice, 2021, (No. 2), published in Statutory Instrument 240 of 2021, is amended by the addition of the following paragraph after paragraph 1(b)—

“(c) the Bachelor of Substantive Law (BLS) Degree; and

(d) the Bachelor of Procedural Law (BLP) Degree.

Provided that registration as a Legal Practitioner on the premise of the Degrees mentioned in subparagraphs (c) and (d) is subject to completion of both degrees. For the avoidance of doubt no one shall be registered as a Legal Practitioner unless they have obtained both degrees above mentioned.”.
